**1)** Had he been working in the garden since early morning?

**Neg:** He had not been working in the garden since early morning.

**2)** Had she been baking a cake since noon?

**Neg:** She had not been baking a cake since noon.

---

**3)** Will he have been playing the guitar for two hours?

**Neg:** He will not have been playing the guitar for two hours.

---

**4)** Will it have been raining all day by the time the outdoor event starts?

**Neg:** It will not have been raining all day by the time the outdoor event starts.

---

**5)** Will you have been working on the project all day long?

**Neg:** You will not have been working on the project all day long.

---

**6)** Had John been studying French for months before his trip to Paris?

**Neg:** John had not been studying French for months before his trip to Paris.

---

**7)** Had I been working on this project for several hours?

**Neg:** I had not been working on this project for several hours.

---

**8)** Has John been studying Spanish for a month?

**Neg:** John has not been studying Spanish for a month.

---

**9)** Will they have been playing soccer since morning?

**Neg:** They will not have been playing soccer since morning.

**10)** Have you been studying English for hours?

**Neg:** You have not been studying English for hours.
