1) Had he been working in the garden since early morning?

Pos: He had been working in the garden since early morning.

2) Had she been baking a cake since noon?

Pos: She had been baking a cake since noon.

3) Will he have been playing the guitar for two hours?

Pos: He will have been playing the guitar for two hours.

4) Will it have been raining all day by the time the outdoor event starts?

Pos: It will have been raining all day by the time the outdoor event starts.

5) Will you have been working on the project all day long?

Pos: You will have been working on the project all day long.

6) Had John been studying French for months before his trip to Paris?

Pos: John had been studying French for months before his trip to Paris.

7) Had I been working on this project for several hours?

Pos: I had been working on this project for several hours.

8) Has John been studying Spanish for a month?

Pos: John has been studying Spanish for a month.

9) Will they have been playing soccer since morning?

Pos: They will have been playing soccer since morning.

10) Have you been studying English for hours?

Pos: You have been studying English for hours.
