

Exercise -Future Perfect Continuous Tense (Key)

1) We will not have been waiting in line for hours.

Pos: We will have been waiting in line for hours.

Que: Will we have been waiting in line for hours?

2) They will not have been rehearsing for the play for weeks.

Pos: They will have been rehearsing for the play for weeks.

Que: Will they have been rehearsing for the play for weeks?

3) It will not have been raining all day.

Pos: It will have been raining all day.

Que: Will it have been raining all day?

4) John will not have been studying for the exam all night.

Pos: John will have been studying for the exam all night.

Que: Will John have been studying for the exam all night?

5) Sarah will not have been working on her novel for months.

Pos: Sarah will have been working on her novel for months.

Que: Will Sarah have been working on her novel for months?
