Pos: You have been working late every night this week.

Neg: You have not been working late every night this week.

2) Had I been studying for the exam all night?

Pos: I had been studying for the exam all night.

Neg: I had not been studying for the exam all night.

3) Had I been working on this project for hours?

Pos: I had been working on this project for hours.

Neg: I had not been working on this project for hours.

4) Had she been baking cookies since this morning?

Pos: She had been baking cookies since this morning.

Neg: She had not been baking cookies since this morning.

5) Had Sarah been practicing her presentation all morning?

Pos: Sarah had been practicing her presentation all morning.

Neg: Sarah had not been practicing her presentation all morning.
