Pos: I had been working on this project for hours.

Que: Had I been working on this project for hours?

4) She had not been baking cookies since this morning.

Pos: She had been baking cookies since this morning.

Que: Had she been baking cookies since this morning?

5) Sarah had not been practicing her presentation all morning.

Pos: Sarah had been practicing her presentation all morning.

Que: Had Sarah been practicing her presentation all morning?
