2) It is raining heavily.

Neg: It is not raining heavily.

Que: Is it raining heavily?

3) She has achieved her goals.

Neg: She has not achieved her goals.

Que: Has she achieved her goals?

4) We believe in the power of positivity.

Neg: We don't believe in the power of positivity.

Que: Do we believe in the power of positivity?

5) You have finished your book.

Neg: You have not finished your book.

Que: Have you finished your book?
