



Perfect continuous Form of Tense **Write Negative Sentences (Key)**

1) Have they been playing basketball since noon?

Neg: They have not been playing basketball since noon.

2) Had I been studying English for two hours?

Neg: I had not been studying English for two hours.

3) Had he been playing video games since morning?

Neg: He had not been playing video games since morning.

4) Will I have been working on this project for three hours by the time you arrive?

Neg: I will not have been working on this project for three hours by the time you arrive.

5) Had Sarah been practicing the piano for years before her concert performance?

Neg: Sarah had not been practicing the piano for years before her concert performance.

6) Had he been playing video games since morning?

Neg: He had not been playing video games since morning.

7) Has she been gardening for hours?

Neg: She has not been gardening for hours.

8) Had I been working on the project all day long?

Neg: I had not been working on the project all day long.

9) Has he been playing video games all day?

Neg: He has not been playing video games all day.

10) Has it been snowing continuously since yesterday?

Neg: It has not been snowing continuously since yesterday.
