1) They will not be going to the beach this weekend.

Pos: *Will they be going to the beach this weekend?*

2) John will not be meeting his friends for lunch tomorrow.

Pos: *Will John be meeting his friends for lunch tomorrow?*

3) Sarah will not be giving a presentation next week.

Pos: *Will Sarah be giving a presentation next week?*

4) I will not be traveling to Europe next summer.

Pos: *Will I be traveling to Europe next summer?*

5) You will not be studying for your exam later.

Pos: *Will you be studying for your exam later?*

6) He will not be playing basketball tomorrow.

Pos: *Will he be playing basketball tomorrow?*

7) She will not be attending a concert tonight.

Pos: *Will she be attending a concert tonight?*

8) They will not be working on the project.

Pos: *Will they be working on the project?*

9) It will not be raining all day tomorrow.

Pos: *Will it be raining all day tomorrow?*

10) I will not be cooking dinner later.

Pos: *Will I be cooking dinner later?*
