

Exercise Key-Perfect Continuous Form of Tense

1) Had it been raining heavily all day long?

Pos: It had been raining heavily all day long.

Neg: It had not been raining heavily all day long.

2) Had he been playing the guitar since the morning?

Pos: He had been playing the guitar since the morning.

Neg: He had not been playing the guitar since the morning.

3) Had the children been playing outside for hours?

Pos: The children had been playing outside for hours.

Neg: The children had not been playing outside for hours.

4) Had she been waiting at the airport for three hours?

Pos: She had been waiting at the airport for three hours.

Neg: She had not been waiting at the airport for three hours.

5) Have I been reading a book since morning?

Pos: I have been reading a book since morning.

Neg: I have not been reading a book since morning.
