Neg: He will not be going on a business trip.

2) Is it thunderstorming?

Neg: It is not thunderstorming.

3) Was the rain stopping?

Neg: The rain wasn't stopping.

4) Will he be playing basketball at the gym later?

Neg: He will not be playing basketball at the gym later.

5) Is she working late tonight?

Neg: She is not working late tonight.

6) Was the car speeding?

Neg: The car wasn't speeding.

7) Was the train arriving at the station?

Neg: The train was not arriving at the station.

8) Was Mary studying in the library?

Neg: Mary was not studying in the library.

9) Will Mary be meeting her friends for lunch?

Neg: Mary will not be meeting her friends for lunch.

10) Were you studying for your exam?

Neg: You were not studying for your exam.
