**1)** Had Sarah been cooking dinner for the family for hours?

**Neg:** Sarah had not been cooking dinner for the family for hours.

**2)** Had they been working on the project for weeks?

**Neg:** They had not been working on the project for weeks.

**Neg:** The students have not been studying for exams.

---

**4)** Has he been practicing his speech?
