

Exercise Key-Perfect Form of Tense

1) Will they have finished the renovation?

Pos: They will have finished the renovation.

Neg: They will not have finished the renovation.

2) Had he bought a new car?

Pos: He had bought a new car.

Neg: He had not bought a new car.

3) Had the train departed by the time we reached the station?

Pos: The train had departed by the time we reached the station.

Neg: The train had not departed by the time we reached the station.

4) Had the train left the station?

Pos: The train had left the station.

Neg: The train had not left the station.

5) Has she finished her work?

Pos: She has finished her work.

Neg: She has not finished her work.
