Neg: It will not have been a fruitful collaboration.

Que: Will it have been a fruitful collaboration?

2) I will have learned a new skill.

Neg: I will not have learned a new skill.

Que: Will I have learned a new skill?

3) You will have traveled to your dream destination.

Neg: You will not have traveled to your dream destination.

Que: Will you have traveled to your dream destination?

4) He will have completed the project on time.

Neg: He will not have completed the project on time.

Que: Will he have completed the project on time?

5) She will have achieved her academic goals.

Neg: She will not have achieved her academic goals.

Que: Will she have achieved her academic goals?
