Write Interrogative Sentences (Key)

1) I will not be studying for the exam tomorrow.

Pos: *Will you be studying for the exam tomorrow?*

2) She will not be working on her project all day.

Pos: *Will she be working on her project all day?*

3) They will not be traveling to Europe next summer.

Pos: *Will they be traveling to Europe next summer?*

4) He will not be playing soccer in the evening.

Pos: *Will he be playing soccer in the evening?*

5) We will not be having dinner at the restaurant.

Pos: *Will we be having dinner at the restaurant?*

6) The sun will not be setting in the west.

Pos: *Will the sun be setting in the west?*

7) You will not be studying for the test tomorrow.

Pos: *Will you be studying for the test tomorrow?*

8) The team will not be practicing for the game.

Pos: *Will the team be practicing for the game?*

9) It will not be raining tomorrow.

Pos: *Will it be raining tomorrow?*

10) Mary will not be meeting her friends for lunch.

Pos: *Will Mary be meeting her friends for lunch?*
