Pos: You will have been working on the project all day long.

Que: Will you have been working on the project all day long?

3) He will not have been playing video games since morning.

Pos: He will have been playing video games since morning.

Que: Will he have been playing video games since morning?

4) She will not have been studying abroad for six months.

Pos: She will have been studying abroad for six months.

Que: Will she have been studying abroad for six months?

Pos: We will have been traveling for hours before we arrive at our destination.

Que: Will we have been traveling for hours before we arrive at our destination?
