Pos: Sarah had been studying Spanish for years before her trip to Spain.

Que: Had Sarah been studying Spanish for years before her trip to Spain?

3) She has not been working on her computer for hours.

Pos: She has been working on her computer for hours.

Que: Has she been working on her computer for hours?

4) John had not been working on his novel for months before he finally completed it.

Pos: John had been working on his novel for months before he finally completed it.

Que: Had John been working on his novel for months before he finally completed it?

5) She had not been cooking dinner for the party all evening.

Pos: She had been cooking dinner for the party all evening.

Que: Had she been cooking dinner for the party all evening?
