Write Negative Sentences (Key)

1) Does the sun shine brightly?

Neg: The sun doesn't shine brightly.

2) Have the children been playing outside all day?

Neg: The children have not been playing outside all day.

3) Are they dancing happily?

Neg: They are not dancing happily.

4) Do they work hard to achieve their goals?

Neg: They don't work hard to achieve their goals.

5) Are the students studying in the library?

Neg: The students are not studying in the library.

6) Does he read books every day?

Neg: He doesn't read books every day.

7) Has he been studying for the test all day?

Neg: He has not been studying for the test all day.

8) Are they dancing happily?

Neg: They are not dancing happily.

9) Is Mary writing a letter?

Neg: Mary is not writing a letter.

10) Is Susan singing a song?

Neg: Susan is not singing a song.
