Neg: The sun doesn't shine brightly.

Que: Does the sun shine brightly?

2) The children have been playing outside all day.

Neg: The children have not been playing outside all day.

Que: Have the children been playing outside all day?

3) They are dancing happily.

Neg: They are not dancing happily.

Que: Are they dancing happily?

4) They work hard to achieve their goals.

Neg: They don't work hard to achieve their goals.

Que: Do they work hard to achieve their goals?

5) The students are studying in the library.

Neq: The students are not studying in the library.

Que: Are the students studying in the library?
