Neg: The sun will not be setting in the west.

5) Sarah will be attending a party.

Neg: Sarah will not be attending a party.

6) He is talking on the phone.

Neg: He is not talking on the phone.

7) The baby is crying.

Neg: The baby is not crying.

8) They were talking on the phone.

Neg: They weren't talking on the phone.

9) Mary was singing a beautiful song.

Neg: Mary was not singing a beautiful song.

10) The cat is meowing.

Neg: The cat is not meowing.
