

Exercise Key-Perfect Continuous Form of Tense

1) Had he been playing video games since morning?

Pos: He had been playing video games since morning.

Neg: He had not been playing video games since morning.

2) Has it been raining since yesterday afternoon?

Pos: It has been raining since yesterday afternoon.

Neg: It has not been raining since yesterday afternoon.

3) Will I have been working on this project for three hours by the time you arrive?

Pos: I will have been working on this project for three hours by the time you arrive.

Neg: I will not have been working on this project for three hours by the time you arrive.

4) Had I been studying for the exam for hours?

Pos: I had been studying for the exam for hours.

Neg: I had not been studying for the exam for hours.

5) Had Sarah been working on her art project all day?

Pos: Sarah had been working on her art project all day.

Neg: Sarah had not been working on her art project all day.
