

Exercise Key-Perfect Continuous Form of Tense

1) He had not been playing video games since morning.

Pos: He had been playing video games since morning.

Que: Had he been playing video games since morning?

2) It has not been raining since yesterday afternoon.

Pos: It has been raining since yesterday afternoon.

Que: Has it been raining since yesterday afternoon?

3) I will not have been working on this project for three hours by the time you arrive.

Pos: I will have been working on this project for three hours by the time you arrive.

Que: Will I have been working on this project for three hours by the time you arrive?

4) I had not been studying for the exam for hours.

Pos: I had been studying for the exam for hours.

Que: Had I been studying for the exam for hours?

5) Sarah had not been working on her art project all day.

Pos: Sarah had been working on her art project all day.

Que: Had Sarah been working on her art project all day?
