Neg: You are not playing soccer.

2) Are they studying together?

Pos: They are studying together.

Neg: They are not studying together.

3) Has it been snowing heavily since morning?

Pos: It has been snowing heavily since morning.

Neg: It has not been snowing heavily since morning.

4) Have they bought new furniture?

Pos: They have bought new furniture.

Neg: They have not bought new furniture.

5) Has he traveled to Europe?

Pos: He has traveled to Europe.

Neg: He has not traveled to Europe.
