**Pos:** You will have been working on the project for several hours.

**2)** It has not been raining since this morning.

**Que:** Has it been raining since this morning?

**3)** We will not have been waiting in line for two hours.

**Pos:** We will have been waiting in line for two hours.

**Que:** Will we have been waiting in line for two hours?

**4)** He had not been playing video games all day.

**Pos:** He had been playing video games all day.

---

**Que:** Had he been playing video games all day?

**5)** We will not have been waiting in line for hours before the store opens.

**Pos:** We will have been waiting in line for hours before the store opens.
