

## Example Sentences of continuous Form of Tense

1) Pos: You will be studying for the exam.

Neg: You will not be studying for the exam.

Que: Will you be studying for the exam?

2) Pos: They will be traveling to Asia next year.

Neg: They will not be traveling to Asia next year.

Que: Will they be traveling to Asia next year?

3) Pos: It was raining heavily.

Neg: It was not raining heavily.

Que: Was it raining heavily?

4) Pos: The cat is purring softly.

Neg: The cat is not purring softly.

Que: Is the cat purring softly?

5) Pos: John will be working on a project this weekend.

Neg: John will not be working on a project this weekend.

Que: Will John be working on a project this weekend?
