

Exercise Key-Perfect Continuous Form of Tense

1) Had they been studying for the exam all week?

Pos: They had been studying for the exam all week.

Neg: They had not been studying for the exam all week.

2) Had I been working on this project for the past week?

Pos: I had been working on this project for the past week.

Neg: I had not been working on this project for the past week.

3) Will Sarah have been working on her novel for months?

Pos: Sarah will have been working on her novel for months.

Neg: Sarah will not have been working on her novel for months.

4) Had it been raining heavily all day long?

Pos: It had been raining heavily all day long.

Neg: It had not been raining heavily all day long.

5) Have they been learning to play the guitar for weeks?

Pos: They have been learning to play the guitar for weeks.

Neg: They have not been learning to play the guitar for weeks.
