

Example Sentences of Perfect continuous Form of Tense

1) Pos: They had been studying for the exam all week.

Neg: They had not been studying for the exam all week.

Que: Had they been studying for the exam all week?

2) Pos: I had been working on this project for the past week.

Neg: I had not been working on this project for the past week.

Que: Had I been working on this project for the past week?

3) Pos: Sarah will have been working on her novel for months.

Neg: Sarah will not have been working on her novel for months.

Que: Will Sarah have been working on her novel for months?

4) Pos: It had been raining heavily all day long.

Neg: It had not been raining heavily all day long.

Que: Had it been raining heavily all day long?

5) Pos: They have been learning to play the guitar for weeks.

Neg: They have not been learning to play the guitar for weeks.

Que: Have they been learning to play the guitar for weeks?
