

Exercise Key-Perfect Continuous Form of Tense

1) Will it have been raining for days by the time we arrive?

Pos: It will have been raining for days by the time we arrive.

Neg: It will not have been raining for days by the time we arrive.

2) Have we been waiting in line for the concert for hours?

Pos: We have been waiting in line for the concert for hours.

Neg: We have not been waiting in line for the concert for hours.

3) Has she been baking a cake for the party?

Pos: She has been baking a cake for the party.

Neg: She has not been baking a cake for the party.

4) Had we been traveling for hours before we arrived at our destination?

Pos: We had been traveling for hours before we arrived at our destination.

Neg: We had not been traveling for hours before we arrived at our destination.

5) Have you been working hard all day?

Pos: You have been working hard all day.

Neg: You have not been working hard all day.
