

Example Sentences of Perfect continuous Form of Tense

- 1) **Pos:** It will have been raining for days by the time we arrive.
Neg: It will not have been raining for days by the time we arrive.
Que: Will it have been raining for days by the time we arrive?

- 2) **Pos:** We have been waiting in line for the concert for hours.
Neg: We have not been waiting in line for the concert for hours.
Que: Have we been waiting in line for the concert for hours?
-

- 3) **Pos:** She has been baking a cake for the party.
Neg: She has not been baking a cake for the party.
Que: Has she been baking a cake for the party?
-

- 4) **Pos:** We had been traveling for hours before we arrived at our destination.
Neg: We had not been traveling for hours before we arrived at our destination.
Que: Had we been traveling for hours before we arrived at our destination?
-

- 5) **Pos:** You have been working hard all day.
Neg: You have not been working hard all day.
Que: Have you been working hard all day?
