1) He wears a red hat.

Neg: He doesn't wear a red hat.

Que: Does he wear a red hat?

2) John has been studying Spanish for a month.

Neg: John has not been studying Spanish for a month.

Que: Has John been studying Spanish for a month?

3) They have eaten dinner.

Neg: They have not eaten dinner.

Que: Have they eaten dinner?

4) We watch the sunset at the beach.

Neg: We don't watch the sunset at the beach.

Que: Do you watch the sunset at the beach?

5) John has been studying Spanish for months.

Neg: John has not been studying Spanish for months.

Que: Has John been studying Spanish for months?
