

Exercise Key-Perfect Continous Form of Tense

1) He had not been playing the guitar since the morning.

Pos: He had been playing the guitar since the morning.

Que: Had he been playing the guitar since the morning?

2) We will not have been waiting in line for hours before the store opens.

Pos: We will have been waiting in line for hours before the store opens.

Que: Will we have been waiting in line for hours before the store opens?

3) You have not been working on the project all day.

Pos: You have been working on the project all day.

Que: Have you been working on the project all day?

4) He had not been working in the garden since early morning.

Pos: He had been working in the garden since early morning.

Que: Had he been working in the garden since early morning?

5) We will not have been waiting in line for two hours.

Pos: We will have been waiting in line for two hours.

Que: Will we have been waiting in line for two hours?
