

Example Sentences of Perfect continuous Form of Tense

1) Pos: He had been playing the guitar since the morning.

Neg: He had not been playing the guitar since the morning.

Que: Had he been playing the guitar since the morning?

2) Pos: We will have been waiting in line for hours before the

store opens.

Neg: We will not have been waiting in line for hours before the

store opens.

Que: Will we have been waiting in line for hours before the

store opens?

3) Pos: You have been working on the project all day.

Neg: You have not been working on the project all day.

Que: Have you been working on the project all day?

4) Pos: He had been working in the garden since early morning.

Neg: He had not been working in the garden since early

morning.

Que: Had he been working in the garden since early morning?

5) Pos: We will have been waiting in line for two hours.

Neg: We will not have been waiting in line for two hours.

Que: Will we have been waiting in line for two hours?
