**Pos:** They have been practicing their lines for weeks.

**Neg:** They have not been practicing their lines for weeks.

**Neg:** We have not been waiting in line for the concert for hours.

**3)** Had it been raining heavily all day?

**Pos:** It had been raining heavily all day.

---

**Neg:** It had not been raining heavily all day.

---

**4)** Had the workers been building the house for months before it was completed?

**Pos:** The workers had been building the house for months before it was completed.

---

**Neg:** The workers had not been building the house for months before it was completed.

---

**5)** Had John been studying English for months before he moved to an English-speaking country?

**Pos:** John had been studying English for months before he moved to an English-speaking country.

---

**Neg:** John had not been studying English for months before he moved to an English-speaking country.
