

Exercise Key-Perfect Form of Tense

1) Has he lived in London?

Pos: He has lived in London.

Neg: He has not lived in London.

2) Have we celebrated the occasion?

Pos: We have celebrated the occasion.

Neg: We have not celebrated the occasion.

3) Had you visited that place?

Pos: You had visited that place.

Neg: You had not visited that place.

4) Had she traveled to Europe last summer?

Pos: She had traveled to Europe last summer.

Neg: She had not traveled to Europe last summer.

5) Will you have learned to play the piano?

Pos: You will have learned to play the piano.

Neg: You will not have learned to play the piano.
