

## Exercise Key-Perfect Continous Form of Tense

1) Had John been working on his novel for months before he finally completed it?

Pos: John had been working on his novel for months before he finally completed it.

Neg: John had not been working on his novel for months before he finally completed it

2) Have I been reading a book for the past hour?

**Pos:** I have been reading a book for the past hour.

Neg: I have not been reading a book for the past hour.

Had we been living in the city for a decade before we moved to the countryside?

Pos: We had been living in the city for a decade before we moved to the countryside.

Neg: We had not been living in the city for a decade before we moved to the countryside.

4) Had you been studying English for a long time before the exam?

Pos: You had been studying English for a long time before the exam.

Neg: You had not been studying English for a long time before the exam.

5) Will she have been writing the book for several years?

**Pos:** She will have been writing the book for several years.

Neg: She will not have been writing the book for several years.
