**Que:** Had we been living in the city for a decade before we moved to the countryside?

**4)** You had not been studying English for a long time before the exam.

**Pos:** You had been studying English for a long time before the exam.

**Que:** Had you been studying English for a long time before the exam?

---

**5)** She will not have been writing the book for several years.

**Pos:** She will have been writing the book for several years.

---

**Que:** Will she have been writing the book for several years?
