

Exercise Key-Perfect Form of Tense

1) Had we visited the museum before it closed?

Pos: We had visited the museum before it closed.

Neg: We had not visited the museum before it closed.

2) Has he won the competition?

Pos: He has won the competition.

Neg: He has not won the competition.

3) Had you finished your homework before the deadline?

Pos: You had finished your homework before the deadline.

Neg: You had not finished your homework before the deadline.

4) Had we booked a table at the restaurant?

Pos: We had booked a table at the restaurant.

Neg: We had not booked a table at the restaurant.

5) Will we have organized a charity event?

Pos: We will have organized a charity event.

Neg: We will not have organized a charity event.
