

Exercise Key-Perfect Continuous Form of Tense

1) Has it been snowing heavily since morning?

Pos: It has been snowing heavily since morning.

Neg: It has not been snowing heavily since morning.

2) Has Mary been playing tennis for years?

Pos: Mary has been playing tennis for years.

Neg: Mary has not been playing tennis for years.

3) Have the students been studying for the test all day?

Pos: The students have been studying for the test all day.

Neg: The students have not been studying for the test all day.

4) Had they been waiting in line for the concert since early morning?

Pos: They had been waiting in line for the concert since early morning.

Neg: They had not been waiting in line for the concert since early morning.

5) Had Sarah been working out at the gym for an hour?

Pos: Sarah had been working out at the gym for an hour.

Neg: Sarah had not been working out at the gym for an hour.
