

Example Sentences of Perfect continuous Form of Tense

1) Pos: It has been snowing heavily since morning.

Neg: It has not been snowing heavily since morning.

Que: Has it been snowing heavily since morning?

2) Pos: Mary has been playing tennis for years.

Neg: Mary has not been playing tennis for years.

Que: Has Mary been playing tennis for years?

3) Pos: The students have been studying for the test all day.

Neg: The students have not been studying for the test all day.

Que: Have the students been studying for the test all day?

4) Pos: They had been waiting in line for the concert since

early morning.

Neg: They had not been waiting in line for the concert since

early morning.

Que: Had they been waiting in line for the concert since early

morning?

5) Pos: Sarah had been working out at the gym for an hour.

Neg: Sarah had not been working out at the gym for an hour.

Que: Had Sarah been working out at the gym for an hour?
