1) You will not have been studying French for six months.

Pos: You will have been studying French for six months.

Que: Will you have been studying French for six months?

2) We had not been living in the city for a decade before we moved to the countryside.

Pos: We had been living in the city for a decade before we moved to the countryside.

Que: Had we been living in the city for a decade before we moved to the countryside?

3) John had not been working on the project for months before it was completed.

Pos: John had been working on the project for months before it was completed.

Que: Had John been working on the project for months before it was completed?

4) I have not been studying English for two hours.

Pos: I have been studying English for two hours.

Que: Have I been studying English for two hours?

5) The children have not been playing outside all afternoon.

Pos: The children have been playing outside all afternoon.

Que: Have the children been playing outside all afternoon?
