1) He reads books every day.

Neg: He doesn't read books every day.

Que: Does he read books every day?

2) He has been studying for the test all day.

Neg: He has not been studying for the test all day.

Que: Has he been studying for the test all day?

3) They are dancing happily.

Neg: They are not dancing happily.

Que: Are they dancing happily?

4) Mary is writing a letter.

Neg: Mary is not writing a letter.

Que: Is Mary writing a letter?

5) Susan is singing a song.

Neg: Susan is not singing a song.

Que: Is Susan singing a song?
