### **Write Negative Sentences (Key)**

**1)** Had Sarah been cooking dinner for the family for hours?

**Neg:** Sarah had not been cooking dinner for the family for hours.

**2)** Had I been working on the project all day long?

**Neg:** I had not been working on the project all day long.

---

**3)** Had John been studying for the exam for months before he finally passed?

**Neg:** John had not been studying for the exam for months before he finally passed.

---

**4)** Will I have been studying English for six months?

**Neg:** I will not have been studying English for six months.

---

**5)** Have we been waiting for our food for a long time?

**Neg:** We have not been waiting for our food for a long time.

---

**6)** Had you been studying for the exam all night?

**Neg:** You had not been studying for the exam all night.

---

**7)** Will they have been rehearsing for the play for weeks?

**Neg:** They will not have been rehearsing for the play for weeks.

---

**8)** Has she been painting a picture all day?

**Neg:** She has not been painting a picture all day.

---

**9)** Had it been raining heavily since yesterday evening?

**Neg:** It had not been raining heavily since yesterday evening.

**10)** Has he been playing football since this morning?

**Neg:** He has not been playing football since this morning.
