

Exercise Key-Perfect Continous Form of Tense

1) Had John been studying for the exam all night?

Pos: John had been studying for the exam all night.

Neg: John had not been studying for the exam all night.

2) Have they been discussing the project all day?

Pos: They have been discussing the project all day.

Neg: They have not been discussing the project all day.

3) Has she been working on her computer all day?

Pos: She has been working on her computer all day.

Neg: She has not been working on her computer all day.

4) Has it been raining since this morning?

Pos: It has been raining since this morning.

Neg: It has not been raining since this morning.

5) Had we been traveling for days before reaching our destination?

Pos: We had been traveling for days before reaching our destination.

Neg: We had not been traveling for days before reaching our destination.
