

Exercise Key-Perfect Continous Form of Tense

1) John had not been studying for the exam all night.

Pos: John had been studying for the exam all night.

Que: Had John been studying for the exam all night?

2) They have not been discussing the project all day.

Pos: They have been discussing the project all day.

Que: Have they been discussing the project all day?

3) She has not been working on her computer all day.

Pos: She has been working on her computer all day.

Que: Has she been working on her computer all day?

4) It has not been raining since this morning.

Pos: It has been raining since this morning.

Que: Has it been raining since this morning?

5) We had not been traveling for days before reaching our destination.

Pos: We had been traveling for days before reaching our destination.

Que: Had we been traveling for days before reaching our destination?
