

Example Sentences of Perfect continuous Form of Tense

1) Pos: John had been studying for the exam all night.

Neg: John had not been studying for the exam all night.

Que: Had John been studying for the exam all night?

2) Pos: They have been discussing the project all day.

Neg: They have not been discussing the project all day.

Que: Have they been discussing the project all day?

3) Pos: She has been working on her computer all day.

Neg: She has not been working on her computer all day.

Que: Has she been working on her computer all day?

4) Pos: It has been raining since this morning.

Neg: It has not been raining since this morning.

Que: Has it been raining since this morning?

5) Pos: We had been traveling for days before reaching our destination.

Neg: We had not been traveling for days before reaching our destination.

Que: Had we been traveling for days before reaching our destination?
