

Exercise Key-Perfect Continuous Form of Tense

1) Had the students been studying English grammar lately?

Pos: The students had been studying English grammar lately.

Neg: The students had not been studying English grammar lately.

2) Had you been studying for the exam all night?

Pos: You had been studying for the exam all night.

Neg: You had not been studying for the exam all night.

3) Had he been playing video games since morning?

Pos: He had been playing video games since morning.

Neg: He had not been playing video games since morning.

4) Have we been waiting for the bus for half an hour?

Pos: We have been waiting for the bus for half an hour.

Neg: We have not been waiting for the bus for half an hour.

5) Had we been traveling around Europe for weeks?

Pos: We had been traveling around Europe for weeks.

Neg: We had not been traveling around Europe for weeks.
