

Exercise Key-Perfect Form of Tense

1) Had he eaten lunch before the meeting?

Pos: He had eaten lunch before the meeting.

Neg: He had not eaten lunch before the meeting.

2) Will I have graduated from college?

Pos: I will have graduated from college.

Neg: I will not have graduated from college.

3) Had you already seen that movie before?

Pos: You had already seen that movie before.

Neg: You had not already seen that movie before.

4) Have they seen a concert?

Pos: They have seen a concert.

Neg: They have not seen a concert.

5) Had she met him before?

Pos: Had she met him before?

Neg: She had not met him before.
