

## Exercise Key-Perfect Continuous Form of Tense

**1)** Had he been working in the garden since early morning?

**Pos:** He had been working in the garden since early morning.

---

**Neg:** He had not been working in the garden since early morning.

---

**2)** Had she been baking a cake since noon?

**Pos:** She had been baking a cake since noon.

---

**Neg:** She had not been baking a cake since noon.

---

**3)** Will he have been playing the guitar for two hours?

**Pos:** He will have been playing the guitar for two hours.

---

**Neg:** He will not have been playing the guitar for two hours.

---

**4)** Will it have been raining all day by the time the outdoor event starts?

**Pos:** It will have been raining all day by the time the outdoor event starts.

---

**Neg:** It will not have been raining all day by the time the outdoor event starts.

---

**5)** Will you have been working on the project all day long?

**Pos:** You will have been working on the project all day long.

---

**Neg:** You will not have been working on the project all day long.

---
