

Exercise Key-Perfect Continous Form of Tense

1) Had he been working in the garden since early morning?

Pos: He had been working in the garden since early morning.

Neq: He had not been working in the garden since early morning.

2) Had she been baking a cake since noon?

Pos: She had been baking a cake since noon.

Neg: She had not been baking a cake since noon.

3) Will he have been playing the guitar for two hours?

Pos: He will have been playing the guitar for two hours.

Neg: He will not have been playing the guitar for two hours.

4) Will it have been raining all day by the time the outdoor event starts?

Pos: It will have been raining all day by the time the outdoor event starts.

Neg: It will not have been raining all day by the time the outdoor event starts.

5) Will you have been working on the project all day long?

Pos: You will have been working on the project all day long.

Neg: You will not have been working on the project all day long.
