

Example Sentences of Perfect continuous Form of Tense

1) Pos: He had been working in the garden since early morning.

Neg: He had not been working in the garden since early morning.

Que: Had he been working in the garden since early morning?

2) Pos: She had been baking a cake since noon.

Neg: She had not been baking a cake since noon.

Que: Had she been baking a cake since noon?

3) Pos: He will have been playing the guitar for two hours.

Neg: He will not have been playing the guitar for two hours.

Que: Will he have been playing the guitar for two hours?

4) Pos: It will have been raining all day by the time the outdoor event starts.

Neg: It will not have been raining all day by the time the outdoor event starts.

Que: Will it have been raining all day by the time the outdoor event starts?

5) Pos: You will have been working on the project all day long.

Neg: You will not have been working on the project all day long.

Que: Will you have been working on the project all day long?
