

## Example Sentences of Perfect continuous Form of Tense

1) Pos: John had been studying French for months before his

trip to Paris.

Neg: John had not been studying French for months before his

trip to Paris.

Que: Had John been studying French for months before his

trip to Paris?

2) Pos: I had been working on this project for several hours.

Neg: I had not been working on this project for several hours.

Que: Had I been working on this project for several hours?

3) Pos: John has been studying Spanish for a month.

Neg: John has not been studying Spanish for a month.

Que: Has John been studying Spanish for a month?

4) Pos: They will have been playing soccer since morning.

Neg: They will not have been playing soccer since morning.

Que: Will they have been playing soccer since morning?

5) Pos: You have been studying English for hours.

Neg: You have not been studying English for hours.

Que: Have you been studying English for hours?
